[English, discriminating, sharp, astute, judicious, perceptive, sensitive, shrewd, Opposite of, **indiscriminate**]

- Yehowah shows that he is **discerning** every inclination of the thoughts of mankind.
- And you, Solomon my son, know the God of your father and serve him with a complete heart and with a delightful soul, for all hearts Yehowah is searching, and every inclination of the thoughts he is **discerning**. If you search for him, he will let himself be found by you. If you leave him, he will cast you off forever. (**1 Chronicles 28:9**)
- The congregator gazed at the inexperienced ones to **discern** a man in want of heart.
- That I might peer upon the inexperienced ones. I was interested in **discerning** among the sons a young man in want of heart. (**Proverbs 7:7**)
- The congregator said that all of his sayings were in righteousness and to the **discerning** one they were straight, or righteous.
- All of them are straight to the **discerning** one, and upright to the ones finding knowledge. (**Proverbs 8:9**)
- A man **discerning** in knowledge will rule long.
- Because of the transgression of a land many are its successive princes, but by a **discerning** man having knowledge of right the prince will remain long. (**Proverbs 28:2**)
- The rich man thinks he is wise, but the **discerning** man searches him through.
- A rich man is wise in his own eyes, but the lowly one who is **discerning** searches him through. (**Proverbs 28:11**)
- Jesus listened well and **discerned** that the man had spoken well.
- At this Jesus, **discerning** he had answered intelligently, said to

him; You are not far from the kingdom of God. But nobody had the courage anymore to question him. ([Mark 12:34](#))

- Jesus listened to their arguments and **discerned** that they were reasoning wrongly in their hearts.
- But Jesus, **discerning** their reasonings, said in answer to them: What are you reasoning out in your hearts? ([Luke 5:22](#))
