~DISCERNMENT (204)

[English, judgment, acumen, discrimination, taste, shrewdness, sensitivity]

- The congregator wanted men to incline their ears to discernment, for from Yehowah God come discernment and knowledge.
- So as to pay attention to wisdom with your ear, that you may incline your heart to discernment. (Proverbs 2:2)
- If, moreover, you call out for understanding itself and you give forth your voice for discernment itself. (Proverbs 2:3)
- For Yehowah himself gives wisdom, out of his mouth there are knowledge and discernment. (Proverbs 2:6)
- Thinking ability itself will keep guard over you, discernment itself will safeguard you. (Proverbs 2:11)
- Happy is the man that has found wisdom, and the man that gets discernment. (Proverbs 3:13)
- Yehowah himself in wisdom founded the earth. He solidly fixed the heavens in discernment. (Proverbs 3:19)
- My son, to my wisdom O do pay attention. To my discernment incline your ears. (Proverbs 5:1)
- Does not wisdom keep calling out, and discernment keep giving forth its voice? (Proverbs 8:1)
- To the stupid one the carrying on of loose conduct is like sport, but wisdom is for the man of discernment. (Proverbs 10:23)
- The one in want of heart has despised his own fellowman, but the man of broad discernment is one that keeps silent. (Proverbs 11:12)
- A man who is himself slow to anger, is abundant in discernment.
- He that is slow to anger is abundant in discernment, but one that is impatient is exalting foolishness. (Proverbs 14:29)

- Ones lacking in discernment, foolishly go about their lives without purpose, while the man of discernment goes straight forward.
- Foolishness is a rejoicing to one who is in want of heart, but the man of discernment is one who goes straight ahead. (Proverbs 15:21)
- A man of discernment is cool of spirit.
- Anyone holding back his sayings is possessed of knowledge, and a man of discernment is cool of spirit. (Proverbs 17:27)
- The stupid ones finds no delight in discernment.
- Anyone stupid finds no delight in discernment, except that his heart should uncover itself. (Proverbs 18:2)
- He that is guarding discernment will find good in life.
- He that is acquiring heart is loving his own soul. He that is guarding discernment is going to find good. (Proverbs 19:8)
- The man of discernment will draw up fine counsel from others.
- Counsel in the heart of a man is as deep waters, but the man of discernment is one that will draw it up. (Proverbs 20:5)
- There is no discernment, wisdom, nor counsel, in opposition to Yehowah God.
- There is no wisdom, nor any discernment, nor any counsel in opposition to Yehowah. (Proverbs 21:30)
- By discernment, a household will be built up, and firmly established.
- By wisdom a household will be built up, and by discernment it will prove firmly established. (Proverbs 24:3)
- A leader who is in want of discernment will practice many fraudulent things.
- A leader that is in want of true discernment is also abundant in

fraudulent practices, but he that is hating unjust profit will prolong his days. (Proverbs 28:16)

- Ezekiel showed, that it was through wisdom and discernment, that the Tyre had made wealth for herself.
- By your wisdom and by your discernment you have made wealth for your own self, and you keep getting gold and silver in your storehouses. (Ezekiel 28:4)
- Daniel and his three companions were selected to be within the court of Nebuchadnezzar because of having wisdom and discernment and knowledge.
- Children in whom there was no defect at all, but good in appearance and having insight into all wisdom and being acquainted with knowledge, and having discernment of what is known, in whom also there was ability to stand in the palace of the king, and to teach them the writing and the tongue of the Chaldeans. (Daniel 1:4)
- Daniel showed that his God Yehowah was a God having discernment, and so he was able to reveal the king's dream to him.
- And he is changing times and seasons, removing kings and setting up kings, giving wisdom to the wise ones and knowledge to those knowing discernment. (Daniel 2:21)
- Then Yehowah God shows, that the Jews have tried to push Yehowah God out to the very boundary of their existence. The very men in covenant with him, have tried to deceive him. The men at peace with the Jews, have prevailed against them. Those eating of their spiritual portions, from the Bible, will place a net under the Jews, as ones in whom there is no discernment.
- As far as the boundary they have sent you. The very men in covenant with you have all deceived you. The men at peace with you have prevailed against you. Those eating food with you will place a net under you as one in whom there is no discernment. (Obadiah 1:7)
- Yehowah God promises to destroy wisdom out of Edom, and discernment out of the mountainous region of Esau, the non-spiritual ones of the earth.

- Will it not be in that day, is the utterance of Yehowah? And I shall certainly destroy the wise ones out of Edom, and discernment out of the mountainous region of Esau. (Obadiah 1:8)
- Jesus told the reader to use his own discernment to identify the disgusting thing that causes desolation, appearing in the time of the end.
- Therefore, when you catch sight of the disgusting thing that causes desolation, as spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in a holy place, let the reader use discernment.

 (Matthew 24:15)
- However, when you catch sight of the disgusting thing that causes desolation standing where it ought not, let the reader use discernment, then let those in Judea begin fleeing to the mountains. (Mark 13:14)
- Paul spoke to men of spiritual discernment, so he asked them to judge for themselves what he spoke of.
- I speak as to men with discernment. Judge for yourselves what I say. (1 Corinthians 10:15)
- One of the gifts of the Holy Spirit, is the discernment of the true meaning of inspired utterances.
- To yet another operations of powerful works, to another prophesying, to another discernment of inspired utterances, to another different tongues, and to another interpretation of tongues. (1 Corinthians 12:10)
- Paul prayed for his spirit anointed Christian brothers to abound yet more with accurate knowledge and full spiritual discernment.
- And this is what I continue praying, that your love may abound yet more and more with accurate knowledge and full discernment. (Philippians 1:9)
- Paul showed that if Timothy meditated on what Paul told him, then the Lord Jesus Christ would give him discernment of all these things in time.

Give constant thought to what I am saying. The Lord will really give you discernment in all things. (2 Timothy 2:7)
