

~DISCRETION (75)

[English, carefulness, prudence, caution, judgment]

- David's wife Abigail was spoken of as a woman of good **discretion** and beautiful in form.
- And the man's name was Nabal, and his wife's name was Abigail. And the wife was good in **discretion** and beautiful in form, but the husband was harsh and bad in his practices, and he was a Calebite. ([1 Samuel 25:3](#))
- David asked God to give Solomon **discretion** and understanding so as to build Yehowah's house and act wisely.
- Only may Yehowah give you **discretion** and understanding, and may he give you commandment concerning Israel even to keep the Law of Yehowah your God. ([1 Chronicles 22:12](#))
- And Hiram went on to say; Blessed be Yehowah the God of Israel, who made the heavens and the earth, because he has given to David the king a wise son, experienced in **discretion** and understanding, who will build a house to Yehowah and a house for his kingship. ([2 Chronicles 2:12](#))
- Then the lot to the east fell to Shelemiah. For Zechariah his son, a counselor with **discretion**, they cast the lots, and his lot got to come out to the north. ([1 Chronicles 26:14](#))
- Hezekiah spoke to all the Levites who were acting with fine **discretion**.
- Moreover, Hezekiah spoke to the heart of all the Levites who were acting with fine **discretion** toward Yehowah. And they proceeded to eat the appointed feast for seven days, sacrificing communion sacrifices and making confession to Yehowah the God of their forefathers. ([2 Chronicles 30:22](#))
- So they brought to us, according to the good hand of our God upon us, a man of **discretion** from the sons of Mahli the grandson of Levi the son of Israel, namely, Sherebiah and his sons and his brothers, eighteen. ([Ezra 8:18](#))

- For their heart you have closed to **discretion**. That is why you do not exalt them. (**Job 17:4**)
- Yehowah as God and king of the earth is acting with **discretion** in all his ways.
- For God is King of all the earth, make melody, acting with **discretion**. (**Psalms 47:7**)
- The Psalmist used **discretion** to walk before Yehowah in a faultless way, in the integrity of his heart.
- I will act with **discretion** in a faultless way. When will you come to me? I shall walk about in the integrity of my heart inside my house. (**Psalms 101:2**)
- A man who uses **discretion** to control his sayings will be praised.
- For his mouth of **discretion** a man will be praised, but one who is twisted at heart will come to be for contempt. (**Proverbs 12:8**)
- Yehowah promised to raise up a righteous sprout to David, a king who would reign and act with **discretion**.
- Look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will raise up to David a righteous sprout. And a king will certainly reign and act with **discretion** and execute justice and righteousness in the land. (**Jeremiah 23:5**)
