~DISEASES (58)

[English, illnesses, sicknesses, ailments, bugs, viruses, infections, syndromes, maladies, disorders]

- Yehowah promised his people that he would remove from them all of the terrible diseases of Egypt on entering the Promised Land.
- And Yehowah will certainly remove from you every sickness, and as for all the evil diseases of Egypt that you have known, he will not place them upon you, and he will indeed put them upon all those who hate you. (Deuteronomy 7:15)
- However if they rebelled and acted as the people of Canaan he would bring all of these diseases back upon them.
- And he will indeed bring back upon you all the diseases of Egypt before which you got scared, and they will certainly hang onto you. (Deuteronomy 28:60)
- And when they went away from him, for they left him with many diseases, his own servants conspired against him because of the blood of the sons of Jehoiada the priest, and they got to kill him upon his own couch, so that he died. Then they buried him in the City of David, but they did not bury him in the burial places of the kings. (2 Chronicles 24:25)
- The report about Jesus healing people of many diseases went out throughout the land.
- And the report about him went out into all Syria, and they brought him all those faring badly, distressed with various diseases and torments, demon-possessed and epileptic and paralyzed persons, and he cured them. (Matthew 4:24)
- This work fulfilled the prophecy that said; He himself carried our diseases. As the scriptures below enumerate.
- That there might be fulfilled what was spoken through Isaiah the prophet, saying; He himself took our sicknesses and carried our diseases. (Matthew 8:17)
- For he cured many, with the result that all those who had

grievous diseases were falling upon him to touch him. (Mark 3:10)

- But when the sun was setting, all those who had people sick with various diseases brought them to him. By laying his hands upon each one of them he would cure them. (Luke 4:40)
- In that hour he cured many of sicknesses and grievous diseases and wicked spirits, and granted many blind persons the favor of seeing. (Luke 7:21)
- So that even cloths and aprons were borne from his body to the ailing people, and the diseases left them, and the wicked spirits came out. (Acts of Apostles 19:12)
