- Job in his sickness lost his desire for food as if his soul saw disease in all foods.
- My soul has refused to touch anything. They are like disease in my food. (Job 6:7)
- Yehowah send a wasting disease upon the Israelites who rebelled against him in the wilderness.
- And he proceeded to give them their request and to send a wasting disease into their soul. (Psalms 106:15)
- Therefore the true Lord, Yehowah of armies, will keep sending upon his fat ones a wasting disease, and under his glory a burning will keep burning away like the burning of a fire. (Isaiah 10:16)
- Yehowah showed that his disobedient people would work hard to produce a harvest, but when it came time for it, it would flee away in disease and incurable pain.
- In the day you may carefully fence about the plantation of yours, and in the morning you may cause the seed of yours to sprout, but the harvest will certainly flee in the day of the disease and incurable pain. (Isaiah 17:11)
- Jesus cured people of every sort of disease and infirmity.
- Then he went around throughout the whole of Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and preaching the Good News of the kingdom and curing every sort of disease and every sort of infirmity among the people. (Matthew 4:23)
- And Jesus set out on a tour of all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and preaching the Good News of the kingdom and curing every sort of disease and every sort of infirmity. (Matthew 9:35)

- Jesus also gave authority to his disciples to cure diseases likewise.
- So he summoned his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits, in order to expel these and to cure every sort of disease and every sort of infirmity. (Matthew 10:1)
