~DISGRACEFUL (114)

[English, shameful, shocking, outrageous, scandalous, dishonorable, discreditable, reprehensible, appalling, dreadful]

- When Jacob's sons learned what Shechem did to Dinah their sister, they viewed it as a disgraceful folly against their family.
- And the sons of Jacob came in from the field as soon as they heard of it, and the men became hurt in their feelings and they grew very angry, because he had committed a disgraceful folly against Israel in lying down with Jacob's daughter, whereas nothing like that ought to be done. (Genesis 34:7)
- An Israelite girl committing prostitution, had committed a disgraceful folly, and was to be stoned to death.
- They must also bring the girl out to the entrance of her father's house, and the men of her city must pelt her with stones, and she must die, because she has committed a disgraceful folly in Israel by committing prostitution in the house of her father. So you must clear away what is bad from your midst. (Deuteronomy 22:21)
- Achan picked up items for himself that were devoted to destruction, and thus committed a disgraceful folly in Israel.
- And it must occur that the one picked with the thing devoted to destruction will be burned with fire, he and all that belongs to him, because he has overstepped the covenant of Yehowah and because he has committed a disgraceful folly in Israel. (Joshua 7:15)
- When a Levite visited the land of Benjamin, the men of that land committed a disgraceful folly regarding his concubine.
- At that the owner of the house went on out to them and said to them; No, my brothers, do not do anything wrong, please, since this man has come into my house. Do not commit this disgraceful folly. (Judges 19:23)
- Here are my virgin daughter and his concubine. Let me bring them out, please, and you rape them and do to them what is

- good in your eyes. But to this man you must not do this disgraceful, foolish thing. (Judges 19:24)
- Hence I grasped my concubine and cut her up and sent her into every field of Israel's inheritance, because they had carried on loose conduct and disgraceful folly in Israel. (Judges 20:6)
- And we must take ten men out of a hundred of all the tribes of Israel, and a hundred out of a thousand, and a thousand out of ten thousand, to procure provisions for the people, that they may take action by going against Gibeah of Benjamin, in view of all the disgraceful folly that they did in Israel. (Judges 20:10)
- Tamar asked her brother Amnon not to commit a disgraceful folly by raping her.
- However, she said to him; No, my brother! Do not humiliate me, for it is not usual to do that way in Israel. Do not do this disgraceful folly. (2 Samuel 13:12)
- Job was told to serve as a priest for his three companions who had committed a disgraceful folly by not speaking what was true regarding Job.
- And now take for yourselves seven bulls and seven rams and go to my servant Job, and you men must offer up a burnt sacrifice in your own behalf, and Job my servant will himself pray for you. His face only I shall accept so as not to commit disgraceful folly with you, for you have not spoken concerning me what is truthful, as has my servant Job. (Job 42:8)
- Sin is something disgraceful to the national groups.
- Righteousness is what exalts a nation, but sin is something disgraceful to national groups. (Proverbs 14:34)
- Yehowah God gives homosexuals and lesbians up to disgraceful sexual appetites, because they have perverted the natural order of things, and do not therefore find true satisfaction by their practices.
- That is why God gave them up to disgraceful sexual appetites, for both their females changed the natural use of themselves into one contrary to nature. (Romans 1:26)

- Paul showed that for a woman to pray without covering her head, was disgraceful, and if she did so then her head should be shorn or shaved.
- For if a woman does not cover herself, let her also be shorn, but if it is disgraceful for a woman to be shorn or shaved, let her be covered. (1 Corinthians 11:6)
- It was disgraceful for a woman to speak or teach within a congregation of spirit anointed Christians, but they should question their husbands at home.
- If, then, they want to learn something, let them question their own husbands at home, for it is disgraceful for a woman to speak in a congregation. (1 Corinthians 14:35)
