**[English, shame, dishonor, discredit, scandal, ignominy, humiliation,
Opposite of, honor]**

- Aaron as High Priest should have stood up to the people. But he let them go unrestrained to their **disgrace**.
- And Moses got to see that the people went unrestrained, because Aaron had let them go unrestrained for a **disgrace** among their opposers. (**Exodus 32:25**)
- The wicked act shamefully and cause **disgrace** to themselves.
- A false word is what the righteous hates, but the wicked ones act shamefully and cause **disgrace** for themselves. (**Proverbs 13:5**)
- You will certainly be satiated with dishonor instead of glory. Drink also, you yourself, and be considered uncircumcised. The cup of the right hand of Yehowah will come around to you, and there will be **disgrace** upon your glory. (**Habakkuk 2:16**)
