

~DISHEARTENED (43)

[English, discouraged, depressed, saddened, dismayed, dejected, disconsolate, downcast, dispirited, crestfallen]

- Moses showed that the people of the land of Canaan would become **disheartened** by the incoming of Israel.
- At that time the sheiks of Edom will indeed be disturbed; As for the despots of Moab, trembling will take hold on them. All the inhabitants of Canaan will indeed be **disheartened**. (**Exodus 15:15**)
- When they went up to the torrent valley of Eshcol and saw the land, then they **disheartened** the sons of Israel, so as not to go into the land that Yehowah was certain to give them. (**Numbers 32:9**)
- Rahab showed that the people of her land were all **disheartened** by Israel's presence and that fright had fallen upon them.
- And she went on to say to the men; I do know that Yehowah will certainly give you the land, and that the fright of you has fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land have become **disheartened** because of you. (**Joshua 2:9**)
- Joshua used this **disheartening** among the Canaanites, to strengthen Israel to go in to take the Promised Land.
- And they went on to say to Joshua; Yehowah has given all the land into our hand. Consequently all the inhabitants of the land have also grown **disheartened** because of us. (**Joshua 2:24**)
- Isaiah prophesies that Philistia must become **disheartened** for out of the north there are the signs of war coming against her.
- Howl, O gate! Cry out, O city! All of you must become **disheartened**, O Philistia! For out of the north a smoke is coming, and there is no one getting isolated from his ranks. (**Isaiah 14:31**)
