[English, defiance, noncompliance, breaking the rules, insubordination, naughtiness, waywardness, Opposite of, obedience]

- Through the disobedience of Adam all men became sinful and likewise through the obedience of one man all will be constituted righteous.
- For just as through the disobedience of the one man many were constituted sinners, likewise also through the obedience of the one person many will be constituted righteous. (Romans 5:19)
- When the Jews became disobedient and rejected Christ then that opened the way for Gentiles to be shown mercy.
- For just as you were once disobedient to God but have now been shown mercy because of their disobedience. (Romans 11:30)
- Yehowah has shut up all of the Jews together in disobedience that he might show all of them mercy.
- For God has shut them all up together in disobedience, that he might show all of them mercy. (Romans 11:32)
- Once the obedience of the 144,000 anointed ones is completed then they will sit in judgment of all mankind and mankind will become responsible for all of their disobedience.
- And we are holding ourselves in readiness to inflict punishment for every disobedience, as soon as your own obedience has been fully carried out. (2 Corinthians 10:6)
- At one time Christians also walked according to the same spirit that now operates in the sons of disobedience.
- In which you at one time walked according to the system of things of this world, according to the ruler of the authority of the air, the spirit that now operates in the sons of disobedience. (Ephesians 2:2)

- Paul showed that to think otherwise was to deceive with empty words because God is going to execute his wrath upon the sons of disobedience.
- Let no man deceive you with empty words, for because of the aforesaid things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience. (Ephesians 5:6)
- Paul showed that the Israelites there in the wilderness did not enter into God's rest because of disobedience, and therefore Christians must keep obedient in everything.
- Since, therefore, it remains for some to enter into it, and those to whom the Good News was first declared did not enter in because of disobedience. (Hebrews 4:6)
- Let us therefore do our utmost to enter into that rest, for fear anyone should fall in the same pattern of disobedience. (Hebrews 4:11)
