~DISPUTING (73)

[English, arguing, disagreeing, quarreling, difference of opinion, heated discussion, clashing, row, Opposite of, agreeing]

- The Psalmist asked God to confuse the wicked ones who caused violence and disputing in the city.
- Confuse, O Yehowah, divide their tongue, for I have seen violence and disputing in the city. (Psalms 55:9)
- It is a glory for a man to desist from disputing.
- It is a glory for a man to desist from disputing, but everyone foolish will burst out in it. (Proverbs 20:3)
- The Pharisees disputed with Jesus seeking a sign from heaven from him.
- Here the Pharisees came out and started disputing with him, seeking from him a sign from heaven, to put him to the test. (Mark 8:11)
- The scribes often disputed with Jesus and his disciples.
- When, now, they came toward the other disciples, they noticed a great crowd about them and scribes disputing with them. (Mark 9:14)
- And he asked them; What are you disputing with them? (Mark 9:16)
- Some of the scribes realized that Jesus spoke well, and asked him what the greatest commandment was.
- Now one of the scribes that had come up and heard them disputing, knowing that he had answered them in a fine way, asked him; Which commandment is first of all? (Mark 12:28)
- After his conversion Paul came to Jerusalem and made attempts to speak, disputing with the Greek speaking Jews, who subsequently tried to kill him.

- And he was talking and disputing with the Greek-speaking Jews. But these made attempts to do away with him. (Acts of Apostles 9:29)
- Paul and Barnabus went up to Jerusalem to consult with the older men there to settle a dispute about circumcision.
- But when there had occurred no little dissension and disputing by Paul and Barnabas with them, they arranged for Paul and Barnabas and some others of them to go up to the apostles and older men in Jerusalem regarding this dispute. (Acts of Apostles 15:2)
- To stop the disputing Peter rose up and told how God had worked through him to bring Gentiles into the congregation.
- Now when much disputing had taken place, Peter rose and said to them; Men, brothers, you well know that from early days God made the choice among you that through my mouth people of the nations should hear the word of the Good News and believe. (Acts of Apostles 15:7)
- When Michael the archangel had a dispute with Satan over Moses body, he said only; May Yehowah rebuke you.
- But when Michael the archangel had a difference with the Devil and was disputing about Moses body, he did not dare to bring a judgment against him in abusive terms, but said; May Yehowah rebuke you. (Jude 1:9)
