## ~DISRESPECTED (43)

[English, insulted, injured, slighted, upset]

- The wicked one making undue profit has blessed himself while disrespecting Yehowah.
- For the wicked has praised himself over the selfish longing of his soul, and the one making undue profit has blessed himself he has disrespected Yehowah. (Psalms 10:3)
- Among the wicked ones God is held in disrespect for they say, Yehowah will not hold an accounting.
- Why is it that the wicked one has disrespected God? He has said in his heart; You will not require an accounting. (Psalms 10:13)
- The Psalmist bemoaned the fact the God's people had disrespected the counsel of Yehowah.
- For they had behaved rebelliously against the sayings of God, and the counsel of the Most High they had disrespected. (Psalms 107:11)
- They did not consent to my counsel, they disrespected all my reproof. (Proverbs 1:30)
- The foolish ones have hated discipline and disrespected even reproof.
- And you will have to say; How I have hated discipline and my heart has disrespected even reproof! (Proverbs 5:12)
- Yehowah shows that those disrespecting his word will become like stubble in a fire.
- Therefore just as a tongue of fire eats up the stubble and into the flames mere dried grass sinks down, their very rootstock will become just like a musty smell, and their blossom itself will go up just like powder, because they have rejected the Law of Yehowah of armies, and the saying of the Holy One of Israel they have disrespected.
