

**~DISRESPECTFULLY (25)**

**[English, rudely, impolitely, discourteously, insolently, impertinently, Opposite of, respectfully]**

- When Dathan and Abiram spoke **disrespectfully** of Moses and Aaron, Yehowah's representatives, the ground opened up and swallowed them down alive.
- But if it is something created that Yehowah will create, and the ground has to open its mouth and swallow up them and everything that belongs to them and they have to go down alive into Sheol, you will then know for certain that these men have treated Yehowah **disrespectfully**. (**Numbers 16:30**)
- Isaiah in his restoration prophecies showed that Israel's circumstance would change and those who once afflicted them and treated them **disrespectfully** would not become their slaves.
- And to you the sons of those afflicting you must go, bowing down, and all those treating you **disrespectfully** must bend down at the very soles of your feet, and they will have to call you the city of Yehowah, Zion of the Holy One of Israel. (**Isaiah 60:14**)
