

~DISRESPECT (103)

[English, disregard, lack of respect, contempt, disrepute, insolence, impertinence, Opposite of, **respect**]

- Yehowah showed that his people, once they had grown fat and fulfilled would show **disrespect** for him and his covenant.
- For I shall bring them to the ground that I have sworn about to their forefathers, which flows with milk and honey, and they will certainly eat and be satisfied and grow fat and turn to other gods, and they will indeed serve them and treat me with **disrespect** and break my covenant. (**Deuteronomy 31:20**)
- Yehowah felt vexation when sons and daughters he had saved through his great power turned to idol worship thus **disrespecting** him greatly.
- When Yehowah saw it, then he came to **disrespect** them, because of the vexation his sons and his daughters gave. (**Deuteronomy 32:19**)
- Elis sons treated the offering of Yehowah with disrespect and their sin became great before Yehowah.
- And the sin of the attendants came to be very great before Yehowah, for the men treated the offering of Yehowah with **disrespect**. (**1 Samuel 2:17**)
- David in his sin with Bathsheba showed **disrespect** for Yehowah and so the life of his son was taken.
- Notwithstanding this, because you have unquestionably treated Yehowah with **disrespect** by this thing, also the son himself, just born to you, will positively die. (**2 Samuel 12:14**)
- Nehemiah confessed that Israel showed great **disrespect** for Yehowah when they made a golden calf to worship.
- Yes, when they had made for themselves a molten statue of a calf and began to say; This is your God who led you up out of Egypt, and they went on to commit great acts of **disrespect**. (**Nehemiah 9:18**)

- Israel committed many acts of great **disrespect**, disobedience, rebelliousness, killing his prophets.
- However, they became disobedient and rebelled against you and kept casting your Law behind their back, and your own prophets they killed, who bore witness against them to bring them back to you, and they went on committing acts of great **disrespect**.
(**Nehemiah 9:26**)
- The Psalmist asks; How long will you tolerate them showing **disrespect**?
- How long, O God, will the adversary keep reproaching? Will the enemy keep treating your name with **disrespect** forever? (**Psalms 74:10**)
- The Psalmist shows that it is a senseless people who show **disrespect** for Yehowah.
- Remember this. The enemy himself has reproached, O Yehowah, and a senseless people have treated your name with **disrespect**.
(**Psalms 74:18**)
- Though called to become a special possession and a holy people Israel showed great **disrespect** for Yehowah and turned backwards.
- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They have left Yehowah, they have treated the Holy One of Israel with **disrespect**, they have turned backwards. (**Isaiah 1:4**)
- Yehowah asks what interest do I have here. For among his people his name is treated with great **disrespect** and there is no justice in the land.
- And now, what interest do I have here? is the utterance of Yehowah. For my people were taken for nothing. The very ones ruling over them kept howling, is the utterance of Yehowah, and constantly, all day long, my name was being treated with **disrespect**. (**Isaiah 52:5**)
- Jeremiah pleads with Yehowah to not **disrespect** them for the sake of his own name and his covenant with their forefathers.

- Do not **disrespect** us for the sake of your name, do not despise your glorious throne. Remember, do not break your covenant with us. (**Jeremiah 14:21**)
- The people of Judah treated Yehowah with such **disrespect** that he caused them to no more be a nation.
- Have you not seen what those of this people have spoken, saying; The two families whom Yehowah has chosen, he will also reject them? And my own people they keep treating with **disrespect**, so that it should no more continue being a nation before them. (**Jeremiah 33:24**)
