- During the ten plagues Yehowah made a distinction between Egypt and Israel after the third plague.
- And Yehowah will certainly make a distinction between the livestock of Israel and the livestock of Egypt, and not a thing of all that belongs to the sons of Israel will die. (Exodus 9:4)
- But against any of the sons of Israel will no dog move eagerly its tongue, from man to beast, in order, that you people may know that Yehowah can make a distinction between the Egyptians and the sons of Israel. (Exodus 11:7)
- Levitical priests were to drink no alcoholic beverages during their temple duties so that they would make a clear minded distinction between what is clean and what is unclean.
- Both in order to make a distinction between the holy thing and the profane and between the unclean thing and the clean. (Leviticus 10:10)
- Yehowah Law also made a clear distinction between clean and unclean foods.
- In order to make a distinction between the unclean and the clean and between the living creature that is eatable and the living creature that may not be eaten. (Leviticus 11:47)
- And you must make a distinction between the clean beast and the unclean and between the unclean fowl and the clean, and you must not make your souls loathsome with the beast and the fowl and anything that moves on the ground that I have divided off for you in declaring them unclean. (Leviticus 20:25)
- Yehowah's house, the temple was to be a place of beauteous distinction to all the lands.
- Accordingly David said; Solomon my son is young and delicate, and the house to be built to Yehowah is to be surpassingly

magnificent for beauteous distinction to all the lands. Let me, then, make preparation for him. So David made preparation in great quantities before his death. (1 Chronicles 22:5)

- During Ezekiel's day the priesthood fell into disrepute by not making a clear distinction between clean and unclean things, and by not keeping Yehowah's Sabbaths.
- Her priests themselves have done violence to my law, and they keep profaning my holy places. Between the holy thing and the common they have made no distinction, and between the unclean thing and the clean they have made nothing known, and from my Sabbaths they have hidden their eyes, and I am profaned in the midst of them. (Ezekiel 22:26)
- Yehowah promised that a day would come when he would make a clear distinction between those serving his acceptably and those who did not.
- And you people will again certainly see the distinction between a righteous one and a wicked one, between one serving God and one who has not served him. (Malachi 3:18)
- Peter spoke that God had made no distinction between Gentiles and Jews in welcoming people into the congregation of God.
- And he made no distinction at all between us and them, but purified their hearts by faith. (Acts of Apostles 15:9)
- Yes, God's righteousness through the faith in Jesus Christ, for all those having faith. For there is no distinction. (Romans 3:22)
- For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for there is the same Lord over all, who is rich to all those calling upon him. (Romans 10:12)
