[English, illustrious, notable, eminent, famous, famed, well known, renounced, great prominent]

- When Moses portion of spirit was divided among 70
 distinguished older men of Israel they got to see a vision of God.
- And he did not put out his hand against the distinguished men of the sons of Israel, but they got a vision of the true God and ate and drank. (Exodus 24:11)
- Abishai was a distinguished man though not considered among the three mighty men of David.
- Although he was distinguished even more than the rest of the thirty, and he came to be their chief, to the rank of the first three he did not come. (2 Samuel 23:19)
- Although he was distinguished even more than the thirty, to the rank of the three he did not come, but David appointed him to his own bodyguard. (2 Samuel 23:23)
- Although he was more distinguished than the thirty, yet to the rank of the first three he did not come. However, David put him over his own bodyguard. (1 Chronicles 11:25)
- At that he wrote them a second letter, saying; If you belong to me, and it is my voice that you are obeying, take the heads of the men that are sons of your lord and come to me tomorrow at this time at Jezreel. Now the sons of the king, seventy men, were with the distinguished men of the city that were bringing them up. (2 Kings 10:6)
- Moreover, Jehu went on to strike down all who were left over of the house of Ahab in Jezreel and all his distinguished men and his acquaintances and his priests, until he had let no survivor of his remain. (2 Kings 10:11)
- Of the three he was more distinguished than the two others, and he came to be a chief to them, and yet he did not come up to the first three. (1 Chronicles 11:21)

- Those who were at ease in Zion her distinguished ones were trusting in the mountain of Samaria.
- Woe to those who are at ease in Zion and to those trusting in the mountain of Samaria! They are the distinguished ones of the chief part of the nations, and to them the house of Israel have come. (Amos 6:1)
- When invited to a marriage feast do not take the most distinguished place at the festivities.
- When you are invited by someone to a marriage feast, do not lie down in the most prominent place. Perhaps someone more distinguished than you may at the time have been invited by him. (Luke 14:8)
