

~DISTINGUISHING (22)

[English, unique, individual, personal, distinctive, characteristic,
Opposite of, **typical**]

- At the rebuilding of the temple in Jerusalem in Ezra's day the people were weeping and rejoicing and not **distinguishing** between the two.
- Hence the people were not **distinguishing** the sound of the shout of rejoicing from the sound of the weeping of the people, for the people were shouting with a loud shout, and the sound itself was heard even to a great distance. (**Ezra 3:13**)
- Daniel, once Babylon had fallen, was **distinguishing** himself over all of the other high officials.
- Then it was that this Daniel was steadily **distinguishing** himself over the high officials and the satraps, forasmuch as an extraordinary spirit was in him, and the king was intending to elevate him over all the kingdom. (**Daniel 6:3**)
