## ~DISTINGUISHING (22)

[English, unique, individual, personal, distinctive, characteristic, Opposite of, typical]

- At the rebuilding of the temple in Jerusalem in Ezra's day the people were weeping and rejoicing and not distinguishing between the two.
- Hence the people were not distinguishing the sound of the shout of rejoicing from the sound of the weeping of the people, for the people were shouting with a loud shout, and the sound itself was heard even to a great distance. (Ezra 3:13)
- Daniel, once Babylon had fallen, was distinguishing himself over all of the other high officials.
- Then it was that this Daniel was steadily distinguishing himself over the high officials and the satraps, forasmuch as an extraordinary spirit was in him, and the king was intending to elevate him over all the kingdom. (Daniel 6:3)
