

~DISTINGUISH (26)

[English, differentiate, tell apart, tell between, discriminate, make a distinction, decide]

- Then your maidservant said; Let the word of my lord the king serve, please, to give rest. For just like an angel of the true God is the way my lord the king is, to **distinguish** what is good and what is bad, and may Yehowah your God himself prove to be with you. (**2 Samuel 14:17**)
- Yehowah knows how to **distinguish** his loyal one and hear his call for assistance.
- So take knowledge that Yehowah will certainly **distinguish** his loyal one. Yehowah himself will hear when I call to him. (**Psalms 4:3**)
- Paul showed that solid food, spiritual food, belongs to those who have been trained to **distinguish** both right and wrong.
- But solid food belongs to mature people, to those who through use have their perceptive powers trained to **distinguish** both right and wrong. (**Hebrews 5:14**)
