## ~DISTRIBUTED (104)

[English, dispersed, spread, disseminated, circulated, scattered, thin, strewn, Opposite of, concentrated]

- The inheritances of Israel were distributed by lot in Shiloh after the taking by Israel of the Promised Land.
- These were the inheritances that Eleazar the priest and Joshua the son of Nun and the heads of the fathers of the tribes of the sons of Israel distributed as a possession by lot in Shiloh before Yehowah, at the entrance of the tent of meeting. So they left off from apportioning the land. (Joshua 19:51)
- David distributed the priestly responsibilities to the priesthood in divisions.
- Then David distributed them in divisions to the sons of Levi, to Gershon, Kohath and Merari. (1 Chronicles 23:6)
- But the sons of Eleazar were found to be more numerous in headmen than the sons of Ithamar. So they distributed them to the sons of Eleazar, as heads for their paternal houses, sixteen, and to the sons of Ithamar, as heads for their paternal houses, eight. (1 Chronicles 24:4)
- Further, they distributed them by lots, these along with those, for there had to be chiefs of the holy place and chiefs of the true God from the sons of Eleazar and from the sons of Ithamar. (1 Chronicles 24:5)
- Rehoboam acted understandingly and distributed some out of all his sons to all the lands of Judah and of Benjamin.
- However, he acted understandingly and distributed some out of all his sons to all the lands of Judah and of Benjamin, to all the fortified cities, and gave them food in abundance and procured a multitude of wives for them. (2 Chronicles 11:23)
- The Psalmist shows that a righteous man had distributed widely, and that his righteousness is thus standing forever.

- He has distributed widely. He has given to the poor ones. His righteousness is standing forever. His own horn will be exalted with glory. (Psalms 112:9)
- Just as it is written: He has distributed widely, he has given to the poor ones, his righteousness continues forever. (2 Corinthians 9:9)
- Jesus miraculously distributed loaves and fishes through his disciples, to large crowds several times.
- Next he commanded the crowds to recline on the grass and took the five loaves and two fishes, and, looking up to heaven, he said a blessing and, after breaking the loaves, he distributed them to the disciples, the disciples in turn to the crowds. (Matthew 14:19)
- So Jesus took the loaves and, after giving thanks, he distributed them to those reclining, likewise also as much of the small fishes as they wanted. (John 6:11)
- Jesus' own garments were distributed by lots to the soldiers who impaled him.
- When they had impaled him they distributed his outer garments by casting lots. (Matthew 27:35)
- And they impaled him and distributed his outer garments by casting the lot over them as to who takes what. (Mark 15:24)
- Tongues as if of fire were distributed about to the waiting disciples in Jerusalem at Pentecost.
- And tongues as if of fire became visible to them and were distributed about, and one sat upon each one of them. (Acts of Apostles 2:3)
- After Joshua defeated seven nations in the land of Canaan, he distributed by lot their land to the Israelites.
- After destroying seven nations in the land of Canaan, he distributed the land of them by lot. (Acts of Apostles 13:19)

- Paul advised all to have a sound mind just as Yehowah God had distributed to them a measure of faith.
- For through the undeserved kindness given to me I tell everyone there among you not to think more of himself than it is necessary to think, but to think so as to have a sound mind, each one as God has distributed to him a measure of faith. (Romans 12:3)
