

~DISTRIBUTE (42)

[English, deal out, hand out, dole out, share out, allocate, give out, dispense, allot, issue]

- Ought they not to find, ought they not to **distribute** spoil, a womb, two wombs to every able-bodied man, spoil of dyed stuffs for Sisera, spoil of dyed stuffs, an embroidered garment, dyed stuff, two embroidered garments for the necks of men of spoil? (**Judges 5:30**)
- Jesus told the rich young ruler to **distribute** to others his possessions and follow him continually
- After hearing that, Jesus said to him; There is yet one thing lacking about you. Sell all the things you have and **distribute** to poor people, and you will have treasure in the heavens, and come be my follower. (**Luke 18:22**)
- When Jesus died on the torture stake the soldiers cast lots to **distribute** his garments.
- But Jesus was saying; Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing. Furthermore, to **distribute** his garments, they cast lots. (**Luke 23:34**)
- The Apostles found it undesirable to leave the study of God's word to **distribute** food to needy widows. Therefore they appointed seven upstanding men to this service.
- So the twelve called the multitude of the disciples to them and said, It is not pleasing for us to leave the word of God to **distribute** food to tables. (**Acts of Apostles 6:2**)
- Paul counsels that the stealer should do hard work so that he will have something to **distribute** to someone in need.
- Let the stealer steal no more, but rather let him do hard work, doing with his hands what is good work, that he may have something to **distribute** to someone in need. (**Ephesians 4:28**)
