~DODO 2 (25)

(Do'do) [from a root meaning beloved]

- A descendant of Benjamin through Ahohi. Dodos son Eleazar was one of David's three mighty men.
- Next to him Eleazar the son of Dodo the son of Ahohi was among the three mighty men with David when they taunted the Philistines. They had gathered themselves there for the battle, and so the men of Israel retreated. (2 Samuel 23:9)
- And after him there was Eleazar the son of **Dodo** the Ahohite. He was among the three mighty men. (1 Chronicles 11:12)
- Dodai, an alternate form of Dodo, served, perhaps in a representative sense through his son Eleazar, as chief of the army division of the second month.
- And over the division of the second month there was **Dodai** the Ahohite with his division, and Mikloth was the leader, and in his division there were twenty-four thousand. (1 Chronicles 27:4)
