[English, hesitant, doubtful, skeptical, distrustful, suspicious, unbelieving, Opposite of, trustful]

- Peter was told to go with the Gentile men, not doubting at all; because Yehowah had himself dispatched them.
- However, rise, go downstairs and be on your way with them, not doubting at all, because I have dispatched them. (Acts of Apostles 10:20)
- So the spirit told me to go with them, not doubting at all. But these six brothers also went with me, and we entered into the house of the man. (Acts of Apostles 11:12)
- James showed that a man who doubts is like a wave of the sea which moves about greatly but accomplishes nothing.
- But let him keep on asking in faith, not doubting at all, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven by the wind and blown about. (James 1:6)
