[English, hesitant, doubtful, skeptical, distrustful, suspicious, unbelieving, Opposite of, **trustful**]

- Peter was told to go with the Gentile men, not **doubting** at all; because Yehowah had himself dispatched them.
- However, rise, go downstairs and be on your way with them, not **doubting** at all, because I have dispatched them. (**Acts of Apostles 10:20**)
- So the spirit told me to go with them, not **doubting** at all. But these six brothers also went with me, and we entered into the house of the man. (**Acts of Apostles 11:12**)
- James showed that a man who **doubts** is like a wave of the sea which moves about greatly but accomplishes nothing.
- But let him keep on asking in faith, not **doubting** at all, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven by the wind and blown about. (**James 1:6**)
