

## ~DOUBT (42)

[English, hesitation, uncertainty, reservation, misgiving, mistrust, disbelief, qualm, suspicion, skepticism]

- The foreigner was told not to say that without **doubt** Yehowah will divide me off from his people.
- And let not the foreigner that has joined himself to Yehowah say; Without **doubt** Yehowah will divide me off from his people. Neither let the eunuch say; Look! I am a dry tree. (**Isaiah 56:3**)
- Jesus, catching Peter's hand said to him; Why did you give way to **doubt**?
- Immediately stretching out his hand Jesus caught hold of him and said to him; You with little faith, why did you give way to **doubt**? (**Matthew 14:31**)
- Jesus encouraged his disciples to have faith in God and not to **doubt** saying that if they had such faith that they could move mountains.
- In answer Jesus said to them; Truly I say to you, if only you have faith and do not **doubt**, not only will you do what I did to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain; Be lifted up and cast into the sea, it will happen. (**Matthew 21:21**)
- Truly I say to you that whoever tells this mountain; Be lifted up and thrown into the sea, and does not **doubt** in his heart, but has faith that what he says is going to occur, he will have it so. (**Mark 11:23**)
- Jesus said no **doubt** you will apply this illustration to me to heal myself.
- At this he said to them; No **doubt** you will apply this illustration to me, Physician, cure yourself. The things we heard as having happened in Capernaum do also here in your home territory. (**Luke 4:23**)
