[English, keenly, enthusiastically, excitedly, readily, willingly, impatiently, fervently, Opposite of, unenthusiastically]

- The tenth plague was against Egypt but Yehowah said that no dog would eagerly move its tongue against anything in Israel.
- But against any of the sons of Israel will no dog move eagerly its tongue, from man to beast, in order, that you people may know that Yehowah can make a distinction between the Egyptians and the sons of Israel. (Exodus 11:7)
- Not a man moved his tongue eagerly against any of the sons of Israel.
- All the people then began to return to the camp, to Joshua, at Makkedah in peace. Not a man moved his tongue eagerly against the sons of Israel. (Joshua 10:21)
- Ezra reported to the King that the work specified of rebuilding Yehowah's house in Jerusalem was progressing eagerly.
- Let it become known to the king that we went to the jurisdictional district of Judah to the house of the great God, and it is being built with stones rolled into place, and timbers are being laid in the walls, and that work is being eagerly done and is making progress in their hands. (Ezra 5:8)
- The wicked one is **eagerly** craving all his days. But the righteous one freely gives and holds nothing back.

- Material things are the things that the nations are eagerly pursuing and God well know what a Christians true physical and spiritual needs are.
- For all these are the things the nations are eagerly pursuing. For your heavenly Father knows you need all these things. (Matthew 6:32)
- For all these are the things the nations of the world are eagerly pursuing, but your Father knows you need these things. (Luke 12:30)
- Christians in Corinth were eagerly waiting for the revelation of Jesus Christ.
- So that you do not fall short in any gift at all, while you are eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Corinthians 1:7)
- Paul showed that we are eagerly waiting for the hoped for righteousness through faith and not that it already was granted.
- For our part we by spirit are eagerly waiting for the hoped-for righteousness as a result of faith. (Galatians 5:5)
- Anointed Christians citizenship exists in heaven from which place we are also eagerly waiting for a savior.

- Paul counseled elders to shepherd the flock of God eagerly.
- Shepherd the flock of God in your care, not under compulsion, but willingly, neither for love of dishonest gain, but eagerly. (1 Peter 5:2)
