[English, keen, enthusiastic, excited, raring to go, ready, willing, impatient, fervent, Opposite of, unenthusiastic]

- Jesus told his disciples that their spirits were eager, but their flesh was weak.
- Men, keep on the watch and praying, in order, that you do not come into temptation. The spirit, of course, is eager, but the flesh is weak. (Mark 14:38)
- Paul showed that the eager expectation of all creation is waiting for the glorious freedom of the sons of God that is to come at the revealing of the sons of God.
- For the eager expectation of the creation is waiting for the revealing of the sons of God. (Romans 8:19)
- Paul showed an eagerness to magnify Christ through his body whether by life or by his death.
- In harmony with my eager expectation and hope that I shall not be ashamed in any respect, but that in all freeness of speech Christ will, as always before, so now be magnified by means of my body, whether through life or through death. (Philippians 1:20)
