

~EBER 5 (20)

(E'ber) [from a root meaning pass over, cross, or, other side, that is, the opposite side]

- **A Levite priest, the head of the paternal house of Amok. Evidently **Eber** was a contemporary of High Priest Joiakim, Governor Nehemiah, and Ezra the priest and scribe.**
- **And in the days of Joiakim there happened to be priests, the heads of the paternal houses, for Seraiah, Meraiah, for Jeremiah, Hananiah. (**Nehemiah 12:12**)**
- **For Sallai, Kallai, for Amok, **Eber**. (**Nehemiah 12:20**)**
- **These were in the days of Joiakim the son of Jeshua the son of Jozadak and in the days of Nehemiah the governor and Ezra the priest, the copyist. (**Nehemiah 12:26**)**
