## ~EBER 5 (20)

(E'ber) [from a root meaning pass over, cross, or, other side, that is, the opposite side]

- A Levite priest, the head of the paternal house of Amok. Evidently Eber was a contemporary of High Priest Joiakim, Governor Nehemiah, and Ezra the priest and scribe.
- And in the days of Joiakim there happened to be priests, the heads of the paternal houses, for Seraiah, Meraiah, for Jeremiah, Hananiah. (Nehemiah 12:12)
- For Sallai, Kallai, for Amok, Eber. (Nehemiah 12:20)
- These were in the days of Joiakim the son of Jeshua the son of Jozadak and in the days of Nehemiah the governor and Ezra the priest, the copyist. (Nehemiah 12:26)
