[English, attempt, try, endeavor, stab, crack, shot]

- Epaphras put himself to great **effort** in behalf of those in Laodicea and at Hierapolis.
- I indeed bear him witness that he puts himself to great **effort** in behalf of you and of those at Laodicea and of those at Hierapolis. (Colossians 4:13)
- Paul showed that it takes **effort** to make our faith turn into virtue and for virtue, to in turn, become accurate knowledge of God and his ways.
- Yes, for this very reason, by your contributing in response all earnest **effort**, supply to your faith virtue, to your virtue knowledge. (2 Peter 1:5)
- Jude made every **effort** to write to his fellow Christians about the faith they hold in common, yet his message had to change to one of putting up a hard fight for that faith.
- Beloved ones, though I was making every **effort** to write you about the salvation we hold in common, I found it necessary to write you to exhort you to put up a hard fight for the faith that was once for all time delivered to the holy ones. (Jude 1:3)
