- Progenitor of an Israelite family of whom 1,254 descendants returned from Babylon with Zerubbabel.
- And these were the sons of the jurisdictional district that went up out of the captivity of the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had taken into exile at Babylon and who later returned to Jerusalem and Judah, each one to his own city. (Ezra 2:1)
- Those who came with Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Seraiah, Reelaiah, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mispar, Bigvai, Rehum, Baanah. The number of the men of the people of Israel. (Ezra 2:2)
- The sons of Elam, a thousand two hundred and fifty-four. (Ezra 2:7)
- The sons of Elam, a thousand two hundred and fifty-four. (Nehemiah 7:12)
- And a later contingent of 71 males accompanied Ezra.
- And of the sons of Elam, Jeshaiah the son of Athaliah, and with him seventy males. (Ezra 8:7)
- Some of his descendants were among those agreeing to put away their foreign wives
- But they promised by shaking hands to put their wives away, and that, they being guilty, there should be a ram of the flock for their guiltiness. (Ezra 10:19)

- And a representative of the family signed the covenant in Nehemiah's time.
- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)
