[English, ecstatic, overjoyed, thrilled, delighted, euphoric, jubilant, excited, in seven heaven, on cloud nine]

- The Psalmist calls for God's people to be elated before Yehowah.
- But as for the righteous, let them rejoice, let them be elated before God, and let them exult with rejoicing. (Psalms 68:3)
- The very goodness of the righteous ones brings elation to a town.
- Because of the goodness of the righteous ones a town is elated, but when the wicked ones perish there is a joyful cry. (Proverbs 11:10)
- Isaiah prophesied that the noise of the highly elated ones would cease in Jerusalem due to her badness.
- The exultation of the tambourines has ceased, the noise of the highly elated ones has discontinued, the exultation of the harp has ceased. (Isaiah 24:8)
- Isaiah also showed that only thorny bushes came up to lead his people a bad fruitage causing sadness to the highly elated town.
- Upon the ground of my people merely thorns, spiny bushes come up, for they are upon all the houses of exultation, yes, the highly elated town. (Isaiah 32:13)
