

**~ELEALEH (44)**  
**(E-le-a'leh)**

- A site regularly mentioned with Heshbon and located in the pastoral country East of the Jordan. The tribe of Reuben built or rebuilt, the city soon after its conquest.
- Ataroth and Dibon and Jazer and Nimrah and Heshbon and **Elealeh** and Sebam and Nebo and Beon. (**Numbers 32:3**)
- The land that Yehowah defeated before the assembly of Israel, is a land for livestock, and your servants have livestock. (**Numbers 32:4**)
- And they went on to say; If we have found favor in your eyes, let this land be given to your servants as a possession. Do not make us cross the Jordan. (**Numbers 32:5**)
- And the sons of Reuben built Heshbon and **Elealeh** and Kiriathaim. (**Numbers 32:37**)
- Centuries later, when it was under Moab's control, Isaiah and Jeremiah prophesied that **Elealeh** was due to cry out at that nations collapse.
- And Heshbon and **Elealeh** cry out. As far as Yahaz their voice has been heard. That is why the armed men of Moab themselves keep shouting. His very soul has quivered within him. (**Isaiah 15:4**)
- That is why I shall weep with the weeping of Jazer over the vine of Sibmah. With my tears I shall drench you, O Heshbon and **Elealeh**, because shouting even over your summer and over your harvest has fallen down. (**Isaiah 16:9**)
- From the cry in Heshbon clear to **Elealeh**, clear to Jahaz they have given forth their voice, from Zoar clear to Horonaim, to Eglath-shelishiyah, for even the waters of Nimrim themselves will become mere desolations. (**Jeremiah 48:34**)
- It is usually thought to be located on a hill at **el-`Al**, about 3 kilometers (2 miles) Northeast of Heshbon.
