(El-e-a'zar) [God Has Helped]

- Son of Dodo the Ahohite, one of David's three outstanding mighty men. At Pas-dammim, during a military campaign with David, **Eleazar** distinguished himself by taking his stand in a field full of barley and single-handedly striking down the Philistines, so that Yehowah saved with a great salvation.
- And after him there was **Eleazar** the son of Dodo the Ahohite. He was among the three mighty men. (1 Chronicles 11:12)
- He it was that happened to be with David at Pas-dammim, where the Philistines had gathered themselves together for war. Now there happened to be a tract of the field full of barley, and the people, for their part, had fled because of the Philistines. (1 Chronicles 11:13)
- But he took his stand in the middle of the tract and delivered it, and kept striking down the Philistines, so that Yehowah saved with a great salvation. (1 Chronicles 11:14)
- Ext to him **Eleazar** the son of Dodo the son of Ahohi was among the three mighty men with David when they taunted the Philistines. They had gathered themselves there for the battle, and so the men of Israel retreated. (2 Samuel 23:9)
- He it was that rose up and kept striking down the Philistines until his hand wearied and his hand kept cleaving to the sword, so that Yehowah performed a great salvation on that day, and as for the people, they returned behind him only to strip those struck down. (2 Samuel 23:10)
