## ~ELIASAPH 2 (33) (E-li'a-saph) [God Has Added (Increased)]

- Son of Lael and chieftain of the paternal house of the Gershonites. Under the direction of Eliasaph, the Gershonites transported the tent coverings and the screen of the tabernacle entrance, the screen of the courtyard entrance and the hangings of the courtyard as well as the tent cords.
- Of Gershon there were the family of the Libnites and the family of the Shimeites. These were the families of the Gershonites. (Numbers 3:21)
- Their registered ones were by number of all males from a month old upward. Their registered ones were seven thousand five hundred. (Numbers 3:22)
- The families of the Gershonites were behind the tabernacle. They were encamped to the west. (Numbers 3:23)
- And the chieftain of the paternal house for the Gershonites was Eliasaph the son of Lael. (Numbers 3:24)
- And the obligation of the sons of Gershon in the tent of meeting was the tabernacle and the tent, its covering and the screen of the entrance of the tent of meeting. (Numbers 3:25)
- And the hangings of the courtyard and the screen of the entrance of the courtyard that is round about the tabernacle and the altar, and its tent cords, for all its service. (Numbers 3:26)
