~ELIEZER 2 (36) (E-li-e'zer) [My God Is Helper]

- The younger of Moses two sons, so named by Moses because God had been his helper in delivering Moses from Pharaoh's sword.
- And the name of the other was Eliezer, because, to quote him, the God of my father is my helper in that he delivered me from Pharaoh's sword. (Exodus 18:4)
- Eliezer had only one son, Rehabiah, through whom came many descendants. In David's day one of these, Shelomoth, along with his brothers, was appointed over all the things made holy.
- And the sons of Eliezer came to be Rehabiah the head, and Eliezer did not come to have other sons, but the sons of Rehabiah did themselves become exceedingly many. (1 Chronicles 23:17)
- As regards his brothers, of Eliezer there was Rehabiah his son and Jeshaiah his son and Joram his son and Zichri his son and Shelomoth his son. (1 Chronicles 26:25)
- This Shelomoth and his brothers were over all the treasures of the things made holy, that David the king and the heads of the paternal houses, and the chiefs of the thousands and of the hundreds, and the chiefs of the army had made holy. (1 Chronicles 26:26)
- And also all that Samuel the seer and Saul the son of Kish and Abner the son of Ner and Joab the son of Zeruiah had made holy. What anyone made holy was under the control of Shelomith and his brothers. (1 Chronicles 26:28)
