- A son born to David in Jerusalem. This Elishama is listed as Elishua in;
- And Ibhar and Elishua and Nepheg and Japhia. (2 Samuel 5:15)
- And Ibhar and Elishua and Elpelet. (1 Chronicles 14:5)
- And in two Hebrew manuscripts at;
- And Ibhar and Elishama and Eliphelet. (1 Chronicles 3:6)
- Elishua is generally considered to be the correct name, as the name Elishama appears again in;
- And Elishama and Eliada and Eliphelet, nine. (1 Chronicles 3:8)
- And therefore could easily have crept into verse 6 through a scribal error. However, since the Hebrew Masoretic text, the Greek Septuagint, the Syriac Peshitta, and the Latin Vulgate read Elishama at;
- And Ibhar and Elishama and Eliphelet. (1 Chronicles 3:6)
- This form of the name has been retained in the New World Translation as well as other translations.
