## ~**ELIZAPHAN 1 (32)**

(E-li-za'phan)[Elzaphan, El-za'phan, My God Has Concealed, Treasured Up]

- The son of Aaron's uncle Uzziel, who, along with his brother Mishael, at Moses direction, carried the bodies of Nadab and Abihu outside the camp.
- And the sons of Uzziel were Mishael and Elzaphan and Sithri. (Exodus 6:22)
- So Moses called Mishael and Elzaphan, the sons of Uzziel, Aaron's uncle, and said to them; Come near, carry your brothers from in front of the holy place to outside the camp. (Leviticus 10:4)
- And the chieftain of the paternal house for the families of the Kohathites was Elizaphan the son of Uzziel. (Numbers 3:30)
- Elizaphan was the ancestral head of a Levitical family, members of which are specifically mentioned in the Bible as serving during the reigns of David and Hezekiah.
- Of the sons of Elizaphan, Shemaiah the chief and his brothers, two hundred. (1 Chronicles 15:8)
- And from the sons of Elizaphan, Shimri and Jeuel, and from the sons of Asaph, Zechariah and Mattaniah. (2 Chronicles 29:13)
