[English, uncomfortable, self-conscious, mortified, humiliated, discomfited]

- They kept urging Elisha until he was embarrassed to look for Elijah.
- And they kept urging him until he was embarrassed, so that he said; Send. They now sent fifty men, and they kept looking for three days, but they did not find him. (2 Kings 2:17)
- Ezra felt shame and embarrassment toward his God over the sinful ways of his people Israel of the past.
- And I went on to say; O my God, I do feel ashamed and embarrassed to raise my face to you, O my God, for our errors themselves have multiplied over our head and our guiltiness has grown great even to the heavens. (Ezra 9:6)
