[English, hugged, held, held in your arms, cuddled, squeezed, held close, clinched]

- Jacob and Laban **embraced** when Rachel told Laban that Jacob had come from a distant land.
- Now it came about that as soon as Laban heard the report about Jacob the son of his sister, he went running to meet him. Then he **embraced** him and kissed him and brought him on into his house. And he began to relate to Laban all these things. ([Genesis 29:13](#))
- Jacob **embraced** Joseph's two sons when giving them the blessing of the firstborn.
- Now the eyes of Israel were dull from old age. He was unable to see. Accordingly he brought them close to him, and he then kissed them and **embraced** them. ([Genesis 48:10](#))
- At Pentecost all those who **embraced** the word of Peter's preaching were baptized.
- Therefore those who **embraced** his word heartily were baptized, and on that day about three thousand souls were added. ([Acts of Apostles 2:41](#))
- Eutychus fell from an upper window while Paul was giving a discourse and Paul ran downstairs and **embraced** him, for he was alive.
- But Paul went downstairs, threw himself upon him and **embraced** him and said; Stop raising a clamor, for his soul is in him. ([Acts of Apostles 20:10](#))
