[English, hug, hold, hold in your arms, cuddle, squeeze, hold close, clinch]

- Jacob and Esau **embraced** after a 20 year separation happy to see each other once again.
- And Esau went running to meet him, and he began to **embrace** him and fall upon his neck and kiss him, and they burst into tears. (**Genesis 33:4**)
- Wisdom will glorify its owner because he **embraces** it.
- Highly esteem it, and it will exalt you. It will glorify you because you **embrace** it. (**Proverbs 4:8**)
- The proverb ask why should my son be in the **embrace** of a foreign woman.
- So why should you, my son, be in an ecstasy with a strange woman or **embrace** the bosom of a foreign woman? (**Proverbs 5:20**)
- The congregator showed that there is a time to **embrace** and a time to keep away from **embracing**.
- A time to throw stones away and a time to bring stones together, a time to **embrace** and a time to keep away from **embracing**. (**Ecclesiastes 3:5**)
- The Shulamite recalled how his right hand would **embrace** her.
- His left hand would be under my head, and his right hand, it would **embrace** me. (**Song of Solomon 8:3**)
- Jesus second set of preaching instructions included as prohibition against **embracing** those mention along the road, thus indicating a more secretive way of working.
- Do not carry a purse, nor a food pouch, nor sandals, and do not embrace anybody in greeting along the road. (**Luke 10:4**)
