

## ~EMINENCE (42)

[English, distinction, renown, reputation, fame, importance, prominence]

- Yehowah is spoken of as the true God of **eminence** who rides upon the cloudy skies
- There is none like the true God of Jeshurun, who rides upon heaven in help of you and upon cloudy skies in his **eminence**. (Deuteronomy 33:26)
- The Psalmist ascribes strength and **eminence** to Yehowah God
- Ascribe strength to God. Over Israel his **eminence** is and his strength is in the clouds. (Psalms 68:34)
- The Psalmist also describes Yehowah as clothed with **eminence** and girded with strength
- Yehowah himself has become king! With **eminence** he is clothed. Yehowah is clothed, with strength he has girded himself. The productive land also becomes firmly established so that it cannot be made to totter. (Psalms 93:1)
- Though wicked ones may be shown favor they refuse to recognize the **eminence** of Yehowah above all mankind.
- Though the wicked one should be shown favor, he simply will not learn righteousness. In the land of straightforwardness he will act unjustly and will not see the **eminence** of Yehowah. (Isaiah 26:10)
- Agrippa and Bernice had many men of **eminence** within the city come in to hear Paul speak.
- Therefore, on the next day, Agrippa and Bernice came with much pompous show and entered into the audience chamber together with military commanders as well as men of **eminence** in the city, and when Festus gave the command, Paul was brought in. (Acts of Apostles 25:23)
