- Yehowah was the eminent sword of Israel helping them to maintain their dominance of the Promised Land.
- Happy you are, O Israel! Who is there like you, a people enjoying salvation in Yehowah, the shield of your help, and the One who is your eminent sword? So your enemies will cringe before you, and you, upon their high places you will tread. (Deuteronomy 33:29)
- The eminent crown of the drunkards of Ephraim referred to Israel's leaders who were a fading decoration for they had lost Yehowah's blessing and would soon go into exile.
- Woe to the eminent crown of the drunkards of Ephraim, and the fading blossom of its decoration of beauty that is upon the head of the fertile valley of those overpowered by wine! (Isaiah 28:1)
- With the feet the eminent crowns of the drunkards of Ephraim will be trampled down. (Isaiah 28:3)
