## ~EN-GANNIM 1 (21) (En-gan'nim) [Fountain or, Spring of Gardens]

- A Judean city in the Shephelah, or lowland, mentioned in the same group as Adullam at;
- In the Shephelah there were Eshtaol and Zorah and Ashnah. (Joshua 15:33)
- And Zanoah and En-gannim, Tappuah and Enam. (Joshua 15:34)
- Jarmuth and Adullam, Socoh and Azekah. (Joshua 15:35)
- Its site is possibly at modern Beit Jimal about 2.5 kilometers (1.5 miles) South of Beth-shemesh, or a site nearby. Umm Jina, which lies about 1 kilometers (0.5 miles) West of Beth-shemesh, has been suggested by some as the site, but it is less probable, because no fountain is found there.
