

~EN-RIMMON (31)

(En-rim'mon) [Fountain or, Spring of the Pomegranate Tree]

- A city of Judah mentioned after the exile as being inhabited by the sons of Judah.
- And as regards the settlements in their fields, there were some of the sons of Judah that dwelt in Kiriath-arba and its dependent towns and in Dibon and its dependent towns and in Jekabzeel and its settlements. (**Nehemiah 11:25**)
- And in **En-rimmon** and in Zorah and in Jarmuth. (**Nehemiah 11:29**)
- Its name is a combination of **Ain** and **Rimmon**, mentioned at;
- And Lebaoth and Shilhim and **Ain** and **Rimmon**, all the cities being twenty-nine, together with their settlements. (**Joshua 15:32**)
- **Ain, Rimmon** and Ether and Ashan, four cities and their settlements. (**Joshua 19:7**)
- And their settlements were Etam and **Ain**, Rimmon and Tochen and Ashan, five cities. (**1 Chronicles 4:32**)
- Today it is generally considered identifiable with **Khirbet Umm, er-Ramamin**, about 15 kilometers (9 miles) to the North of Beer-sheba.
