## ~EN-RIMMON (31)

(En-rim'mon) [Fountain or, Spring of the Pomegranate Tree]

- A city of Judah mentioned after the exile as being inhabited by the sons of Judah.
- And as regards the settlements in their fields, there were some of the sons of Judah that dwelt in Kiriath-arba and its dependent towns and in Dibon and its dependent towns and in Jekabzeel and its settlements. (Nehemiah 11:25)
- And in En-rimmon and in Zorah and in Jarmuth. (Nehemiah 11:29)
- Its name is a combination of Ain and Rimmon, mentioned at;
- And Lebaoth and Shilhim and Ain and Rimmon, all the cities being twenty-nine, together with their settlements. (Joshua 15:32)
- Ain, Rimmon and Ether and Ashan, four cities and their settlements. (Joshua 19:7)
- And their settlements were Etam and Ain, Rimmon and Tochen and Ashan, five cities. (1 Chronicles 4:32)
- Today it is generally considered identifiable with Khirbet Umm, er-Ramamin, about 15 kilometers (9 miles) to the North of Beer-sheba.
