(E'nam) [related to *'a'yin*, fountain, spring]

- A city in the Shephelah of Judah.
- In the Shephelah there were Eshtaol and Zorah and Ashnah. (Joshua 15:33)
- And Zanoah and En-gannim, Tappuah and Enam. (Joshua 15:34)
- Although Enam's exact location is today unknown, some geographers consider it to be the same as Enaim mentioned at;
- With that she removed the garments of her widowhood from her and covered herself with a shawl and veiled herself and sat down at the entrance of Enaim, which is along the road to Timnah. For she saw that Shelah had grown up and yet she had not been given as a wife to him. (Genesis 38:14)
- And he went inquiring of the men of her place, saying; Where is that temple prostitute in Enaim along the road? But they kept saying; No temple prostitute has ever been in this place. (Genesis 38:21)
