- Draw me with you. Let us run. The king has brought me into his interior rooms! Do let us be joyful and rejoice in you. Do let us mention your expressions of **endearment** more than wine. Deservedly they have loved you. ([Song of Solomon 1:4](#))
- How beautiful your expressions of **endearment** are, O my sister, my bride! How much better your expressions of endearment are than wine and the fragrance of your oils than all sorts of perfume! ([Song of Solomon 4:10](#))
- I have come into my garden, O my sister, my bride. I have plucked my myrrh along with my spice. I have eaten my honeycomb along with my honey. I have drunk my wine along with my milk. Eat, O companions! Drink and become drunk with expressions of **endearment**! ([Song of Solomon 5:1](#))
- Do let us rise early and go to the vineyards, that we may see whether the vine has sprouted, the blossom has burst open, the pomegranate trees have bloomed. There I shall give my expressions of **endearment** to you. ([Song of Solomon 7:12](#))
