[English, take pleasure in, like, give pleasure to]

- Persons making incense like that made for the temple for their own use so as to **enjoy** its smell, were to be cut off from the people.
- Whoever makes any like it to **enjoy** its smell must be cut off from his people. (**Exodus 30:38**)
- The apostate will be giving back his acquired property, like wealth from his trade, but which he will not **enjoy**.
- He will be giving back his acquired property and will not swallow it down, like wealth from his trade, but which he will not **enjoy**. (**Job 20:18**)
- The Psalmist showed, that he used to **enjoy** the sweet intimacy of association with his brothers at the temple of Yehowah God.
- Because we used to **enjoy** sweet intimacy together, into the house of God we used to walk with the throng. (**Psalms 55:14**)
- The congregator speaks of a prostitute who invites men to **enjoy** love's expressions with her.
- Do come, let us drink our fill of love until the morning, do let us **enjoy** each other with love expressions. (**Proverbs 7:18**)
- Through Amos, Yehowah God showed, that he had rejected Israel's festivals, and did not **enjoy** the smell of their solemn assemblies.
- I have hated, I have rejected your festivals, and I shall not **enjoy** the smell of your solemn assemblies. (**Amos 5:21**)
- The rich man of Jesus' parable stored up riches, thinking within himself that he would **enjoy** them in his old age, but then he died suddenly.
- And I will say to my soul; Soul, you have many good things laid up for many years, take your ease, eat, drink, **enjoy** yourself. (**Luke 12:19**)

- In Jesus parable of the prodigal son, when the son returned to his father, he slaughtered a young bull so that they could **enjoy** themselves and rejoice in his return.
- And bring the fattened young bull, slaughter it and let us eat and **enjoy** ourselves. (Luke 15:23)
- Because this my son was dead and came to life again, he was lost and was found. And they started to **enjoy** themselves. (Luke 15:24)
- In reply he said to his father; Here it is so many years I have slaved for you and never once did I transgress your commandment, and yet to me you never once gave a kid for me to **enjoy** myself with my friends. (Luke 15:29)
- But we just had to **enjoy** ourselves and rejoice, because this your brother was dead and came to life, and he was lost and was found. (Luke 15:32)
- Israel in the wilderness made a calf to worship and began to **enjoy** themselves in the works of their hands.
- So they made a calf in those days and brought up a sacrifice to the idol and began to **enjoy** themselves in the works of their hands. (Acts of Apostles 7:41)
- Tertullus buttered up Felix, saying that the Jews enjoyed great peace while under his rulership.
- When he was called, Tertullus started accusing him, saying; Seeing that we **enjoy** great peace through you and that reforms are taking place in this nation through your forethought. (Acts of Apostles 24:2)
- Julius permitted Paul to **enjoy** the company of his friends while on their journey to Rome, at a stopover, though Paul was a prisoner.
- And the next day we landed at Sidon, and Julius treated Paul with human kindness and permitted him to go to his friends and **enjoy** their care. (Acts of Apostles 27:3)

- **Now that spirit anointed Christians have been declared righteous through faith, they can **enjoy** peace with Yehowah God through Jesus Christ.**
- **Therefore, now that we have been declared righteous as a result of faith, let us **enjoy** peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. (**Romans 5:1**)**
- **When Yehowah God's two prophets are killed, those dwelling upon the earth, send gifts to one another and **enjoy** themselves over their demise.**
- **And those dwelling on the earth rejoice over them and **enjoy** themselves, and they will send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those dwelling on the earth. (**Revelation 11:10**)**
