

~ENSLAVED (29)

[English, imprisoned, in prison, incarcerated, locked up, confined, caged, Opposite of, **free**]

- Paul showed that when Christians first come to know the truth that they are still **enslaved** by the elementary things of the truth, but that later as they mature they apply Christian counsel to changing their lives according to God's will.
- Likewise we also, when we were babes, continued **enslaved** by the elementary things belonging to the world. (**Galatians 4:3**)
- Paul counseled for the aged women not to be **enslaved** by a lot of wine, but to be teachers of what is good.
- Likewise let the aged women be reverent in behavior, not slanderous, neither **enslaved** to a lot of wine, teachers of what is good. (**Titus 2:3**)
- Peter showed that whoever is overcome by another person is then **enslaved** by that one. Some were promising Christians freedom, but they were really **enslaving** them to corruption.
- While they are promising them freedom, they themselves are existing as slaves of corruption. For whoever is overcome by another is **enslaved** by this one. (**2 Peter 2:19**)
