[English, attentive, intent, fascinated, spellbound, rapt, trapped]

- Yehowah warned Israel to completely destroy the God's of Canaan for fear that they might be ensnared by them.
- The graven images of their gods you should burn in the fire. You must not desire the silver and the gold upon them, nor indeed take it for yourself, for fear you may be ensnared by it, for it is a thing detestable to Yehowah your God. (Deuteronomy 7:25)
- Yehowah's judgment of all men is that they will reap what they have sown, therefore the very activity of wicked ones proves to ensure them.
- Yehowah is known by the judgment that he has executed. By the activity of his own hands the wicked one has been ensnared. (Psalms 9:16)
- The Bible warns us to be careful about what we commit to do or promise so as not to become ensnared by the sayings of our mouths.
- If you have been ensnared by the sayings of your mouth, if you have been caught by the sayings of your mouth. (Proverbs 6:2)
- By the transgression of the lips the bad person is ensnared, but the righteous one gets out of distress. (Proverbs 12:13)
- The congregator showed that Yehowah day will come in upon mankind like a trap, suddenly, for it will be a calamitous time.
- For man also does not know his time. Just like fishes that are being taken in an evil net, and like birds that are being taken in a trap, so the sons of men themselves are being ensnared at a calamitous time, when it falls upon them suddenly. (Ecclesiastes 9:12)
- Isaiah showed that men would become rote in their doing of God's will and worship and that they would make backward spring progress and then be ensnared and caught.
- And to them the word of Yehowah will certainly become

command upon command, command upon command, measuring line upon measuring line, measuring line upon measuring line, here a little, there a little, in order, that they may go and certainly stumble backwards and actually be broken and ensnared and caught. (Isaiah 28:13)
